## PRESS NOTE

The Department of Fisheries, A&N Administration invites applications from the licensed fisher holding registered traditional/ motorized / mechanized fishing vessel and possessing valid fishing license at least for the last 01 (one) year apart from the current year or Registered Fisheries Cooperative Society / Federation/ Self Help Group engaged in fishing activity/ retail marketing of fish for availing subsidy for the purchase of insulated ice boxes under the programme "**Supply of Insulated Ice Boxes on subsidy to fishers**" under the Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana (RKVY).

The programme envisages providing of subsidy at the rate of 50% of the actual cost of the Insulated Ice Box subject to a maximum of Rs.10,000/- per ice box of 150 ltrs/ 200 ltrs to 700 ltrs capacity. Each applicant engaged in retail marketing of fish is eligible to avail subsidy for purchase of maximum of 02 Nos. of Ice Boxes of maximum 150 ltrs capacity. Applicants engaged in fishing activity are eligible to avail subsidy for purchase of maximum of 04 Nos. of insulated ice boxes having capacity of 200 ltrs to 700 ltrs.

Application form and detailed terms and conditions of the programme can be obtained from the Directorate of Fisheries/all Fisheries Zonal Offices/Fisheries Sub Offices/Zilla Parishads and the completed applications may be submitted to the concerned Fisheries Zonal Offices/Fisheries Sub Offices/Zilla Parishads. The application form can also be downloaded from the A&N Administration's website, [www.and.nic.in](http://www.and.nic.in). The application should reach the concerned offices on or before **29.10.2010**.

The Department of Fisheries shall implement the programme strictly in accordance with the laid down procedure.





Name of the Programme	<b>Supply of insulated ice boxes on subsidy to fishers of Andaman and Nicobar Islands.</b>
Objective	To provide facility for proper preservation and storage of fish catch in iced condition to maintain quality of fish catch for better economic returns.

<p>Procedure for inviting applications and release of subsidy</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) Inviting applications from the interested beneficiary by releasing press note in the local Dailies/AIR/Door-Darshan as well by giving wide publicity through its Zonal Offices/ Sub-Stations and also through the PRIs.</li> <li>2) Submission of application by interested beneficiary in the prescribed format.</li> <li>3) Field verification report and recommendation of the Field Officer and Zonal Fisheries In-charge.</li> <li>4) Selection of beneficiary and fixation of admissible amount of subsidy for different capacities of ice box by a constituted committee and approval by the competent authority for sanction of admissible subsidy to the selected beneficiary.</li> <li>5) Intimation to the selected beneficiaries through the respective Zonal Fisheries In-charges and execution of agreement by selected beneficiaries and the Asst. Director of Fisheries of the Zonal Office.</li> <li>6) Procurement of the asset by the beneficiary.</li> <li>7) Intimation / submission of bills to the Zonal Officer In-charge by the beneficiary.</li> </ol>

- 8) Inspection of the asset and verification of the bills by the Station in-charge/Zonal In-charge.
- 9) Forwarding of verified bills and agreement executed by the beneficiary together with the report of the Zonal In-charge to the Department of Fisheries.
- 10) Release of subsidy to the beneficiary through the bank wherever bank loan is involved or to beneficiary on reimbursement basis after verification of the asset in case no bank loan is involved.
- 11) Inspection and reporting by Station in-charge/ Zonal in-charge to the Director of Fisheries on the utilization of the asset once in six months for a period two years.

Now, it is hereby agreed between the parties here to that in consideration of the grant of subsidy for procurement of Insulated Ice Box by the Govt., the first party agrees with the Govt. as here in after mentioned.

1. The first party will be given a amount of Rs. .... (Rupees ..... ) subsidy for procurement of

2. The first party has agreed that no part of the subsidy shall be utilized for purposes other than those for which it is sanctioned.
3. The first party agrees that assets created out of the subsidy shall not be disposed off or sold.
4. The first party agrees to keep the Insulated Ice Box in good working condition and carry out repairs when ever necessary at its own expense and to indemnify the Govt. against any loss or damage that may be caused to the Insulated Ice Box or any part thereof.
5. The first party shall permit any officer authorized by the A & N Administration the Zonal Assistant Director of Fisheries to examine the condition of the Insulated Ice Box in such manner as the said officer may deem fit.
6. If at any time the Insulated Ice Box is found neglected or in abandoned condition, it shall be lawful for the Govt. or any officer authorized by it to order the seizure of Insulated Ice Box.
7. If at any time during the period of agreement the Govt. notices that the first party misuses the Insulated Ice Box for the purpose other than fish storage, the amount of subsidy shall be turned into loan and shall be recovered from the first party in lump sum with interest @ of 8% per annum, as if it were an arrear of land revenue.
