
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**RASHTRIYA KRISHI VIKAS YOJANA (RKVY)**  
Guidelines for implementation of the programme

Name of the Programme	<b>Subsidy for purchase of freshwater fish harvesting net</b>
Objective	The programme aims to provide subsidy to the pisciculturists of A&N Islands to acquire their own fish harvesting net for harvesting of fresh water fish from their fish ponds.
Pattern of Assistance / Subsidy	50% subsidy subject to a maximum of Rs.9,000/- for purchase of one fish harvesting net made of nylon webbing of size (210/3/3), fitted with head and foot rope, PVC floats, lead sinker, with 50% required hanging of length not less than 200ft, width 20ft and mesh size of 1 inch. (The actual amount of subsidy for the fish harvesting net of the specified size to be decided by a constituted committee)
Eligibility Criteria	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) The applicant should be holding a clear title of the land on which the pond is located (copy of land record alongwith a certificate of ownership from the Revenue Department to be furnished).</li> <li>2) If the land is on lease, the lease deed shall be for a minimum of 5 years from the date of sanction of subsidy (Copy of lease deed to be furnished).</li> <li>3) The pond should be in use for stocking of fresh water fish/ prawn atleast for last 01 year including current year.</li> <li>4) The subsidy shall be available only for fresh purchases.</li> </ol>
Procedure for release of subsidy	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) Inviting of applications through local dailies/ AIR/ Fisheries Zonal Offices/ Fisheries Sub Offices/ PRI's/ Municipal Council and Tribal Council.</li> <li>2) Submission of application by pisciculturists in the prescribed format.</li> </ol>



	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>3) Field verification report and recommendation of the Field Officer and Zonal Fisheries In-charge.</li><li>4) Selection of beneficiary through a constituted committee and approval by the competent authority for sanction of admissible subsidy to the selected beneficiary for the procurement of fish harvesting net.</li><li>5) Intimation to the selected beneficiaries through the respective Zonal Fisheries In-charges and execution of agreement bond and surety bond by the Asst. Director of Fisheries of the Zonal Office and the beneficiary.</li><li>6) Procurement of the asset by the beneficiary.</li><li>7) Intimation to the In-charge, Zonal Office / Fisheries Sub Station by the beneficiary.</li><li>8) Inspection of the asset and verification of the bills by the In-charge, Fisheries Sub Station/ Zonal Office.</li><li>9) Execution of the agreement between the beneficiary and the In-charge of the respective Zonal Office.</li><li>10) Forwarding of verified bills, agreement bond and surety bond executed by the beneficiary together with the report of the Zonal In-charge to the Directorate of Fisheries.</li><li>11) Release of subsidy to the beneficiary through the bank wherever bank loan is involved, or To the agency that supplies the fish harvesting net in cases where the beneficiary has remitted only the balance cost of the asset excluding the sanctioned subsidy, or To the beneficiary incases where the total cost of the asset has been paid in full to the supplier by the beneficiary.</li></ol>


**For grant of 50% Subsidy for purchase of freshwater fish harvesting net**

(Name of the District) in Andaman & Nicobar Islands hereinafter referred to as "Beneficiary" (which expression shall unless repugnant to the subject or context or meaning thereof be deemed to include his/ her/ their respective heirs, executors, administrator, legal representatives and assignees) of the FIRST PART, and

The President of India acting through the Assistant Director of Fisheries, Andaman and Nicobar Administration, Port Blair, herein after referred to as the "Administration" (Which expression shall unless repugnant to the subject or context or meaning thereof be deemed to include its successors and assignees) of the SECOND PART, and

**NOW WHEREAS**

1. The Administration has framed a programme called "Subsidy for purchase of freshwater fish harvesting net" under the Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana – a plan scheme of the Ministry of Agriculture, Govt. of India (herein after referred to as "the said programme") with a view to provide subsidy to the pisciculturists of A&N Islands to acquire their own fish harvesting net for harvesting of fresh water fish from their fish ponds and the said Beneficiary agrees to the terms and conditions laid down under the said programme.
2. Under the said programme, the Beneficiary is eligible for subsidy to the extent of 50% subject to a maximum of Rs.9,000/- for purchase of fish




harvesting net made of nylon webbing of size (210/3/3), fitted with head and foot rope, PVC floats, lead sinker, with 50% required hanging of length not less than 200ft, width 20ft and mesh size of 1 inch.

3. The Beneficiary has applied to the Administration for providing of subsidy for procurement of one fish harvesting net and the Administration have agreed to provide Rs. .... being the 50% cost of the item as subsidy for procurement of the fish harvesting net.

**NOW THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH** and it is hereby agreed by and between the parties here to as under:-

- a) The Beneficiary agrees to procure one fish harvesting net within 90 days from the date of sanction of subsidy under the said Programme.
- b) The Beneficiary has agreed that no part of the subsidy shall be utilized for purposes other than those for which it is sanctioned.
- c) The Beneficiary agrees that assets created out of the subsidy shall not be disposed off or sold.
- d) The Beneficiary agrees to keep the fish harvesting net in perfect working condition and carry out repairs when ever necessary at its own expense and to indemnify the Administration against any loss or damage that may be caused to the fish harvesting net or any part thereof.
- e) The Beneficiary shall permit any officer authorized by the Administration to inspect the condition of the fish harvesting net in such manner as the said officer may deem fit.
- f) If at any time the fish harvesting net is found neglected or in abandoned condition, it shall be lawful for the Administration or any officer authorized by it to order the seizure of fish harvesting net and to recover the cost from the Beneficiary as arrears of land revenue.
- g) If at any time during the period of agreement the Administration notices that the first party misuse or mis-utilise the fish harvesting net for the purpose other than fish harvesting, the amount subsidized shall be turned into loan and shall be recovered from the Beneficiary.
- h) This agreement shall remain in force for a period of five years.



- i) In case of the breach of any condition of this agreement by the Beneficiary, the Administration shall have the right to withdraw the subsidy and order it's recovery as arrears of land revenue.
- j) In the event of any dispute or difference arising between the parties here to in respect of or in relation to this agreement or any provisions herein contained during the subsistence of this agreement, the same shall be referred to the Sole Arbitrator appointed by the Commissioner.-cum.-Secy (Fy)., A&N Administration, under the provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996. The Arbitration proceedings shall be held at Port Blair.
- k) The Beneficiary hereby agrees to bear and pay all the cost/ charges and the expenses incidental to the preparation and the execution of this agreement.


