

PRESS NOTICE

is brought to the notice of all concerned candidates of A&N Islands that applications are invited from Indian students for admission in MBBS/BDS courses in Govt. owned Medical/Dental Colleges in Bangladesh for the academic session 2008-09 under the SAARC quota by High Commission of Bangladesh in New Delhi. The availability of MBBS and BDS seats for students from India are 13 and 1 respectively. The filled-in application forms in the prescribed proforma in triplicate alongwith attested copies of all required testimonials/certificates and 6 (six) passport size photographs of the candidate should reach the Development-IV Section, Secretariat, Port Blair latest by 1st December, 2008. As per the communication received from the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, the filled-in application form alongwith all necessary documents should reach the Ministry of External Affairs, Govt. of India by 01.12.2008.

The criteria for admission and format of application form are given below :-

Criteria for Admission of Foreign Students in the MBBS and BDS courses in the Government-owned Medical Colleges in Bangladesh for 2008-2009 academic year under Self – finance Scheme.

- A) Equivalence of Foreign Degree
- Must have passed qualifying examinations (HSC/'A' level or equivalent exam).
 - SSC/'O' level or equivalent Exam passed not before 2005.
 - HSC/'A' level or equivalent Exam passed not after 2008.
 - Minimum GPA of SSC+HSC total: 8.00 (Eight).
 - Minimum GPA either in SSC and HSC : 3.50
- ❖ For the students who passed 'O' level (SSC/'O' level or equivalent exam) – only top 5 subjects are considered (Score basis)
– Calculation of GPA in 'O' level = (Sum total of the Grade Points in top Five subjects + 5).
- ❖ For the Students who passed 'A' level (HSC)/'A' level or equivalent exam – Only 3 (three) subjects namely Physics, Chemistry and Biology are considered. Minimum qualification Grade "D" in Biology is obligatory.
– Calculation of GPA in 'A' level = Sum total of the grade points in 3 subjects +3).
- B) Application form : Duly filled in application forms in triplicate along with following documents and 6 pieces of passport size photos are to reach the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Dhaka latest by 7 December 2008.
- i) Mark-sheet/Academic Transcript of SSC/'O' level or equivalent exam passed not before 2005.
 - ii) Mark-sheet/Academic Transcript of HSC/'A' level or equivalent exam passed not after 2008.
- ❖ All the certificates must be attested by the competent authority, that is the Foreign Ministry of the respective country and also authenticated by the respective Bangladesh Missions abroad.
- ❖ The successful applicants will require to produce all academic certificates and mark-sheets in original during their admission.

- C) Fees : Students from SAARC countries will require to pay tuition and other fees at the rate charged to a Bangladeshi student. The students from other countries will require to pay US\$3000 (Three Thousand only) per academic year in addition to the tuition fees at the rate charged to Bangladeshi students.
- D) Bank Draft : Each applicant must have to attach with his/her application a non-refundable Demand Draft of US\$50 (fifty) payable to the Director, Medical Education & HMPD, DGHS, Mohakhali, Dhaka, Bangladesh.
- E) Applications transmitted through Bangladesh Missions abroad would only be considered for admission procedure. Applications (Through Missions) must reach the Ministry of Foreign Affairs not later than 7 December 2008.




