NOTIFICATION

No. F.No.12-39/2007 -Labour. In exercise of the powers conferred by clause(b) of sub-section (1) of section 3 and sub-section (2) of section 5 of the Minimum Wages Act, 1948 (Acts XI of 1948) read with Notification No.LP 24 (1) dated the 16 march, 1949 of the Govt. of India in the Ministry of Labour and in suppression of the Andaman and Nicobar Administration's Notification No. 203/2006 /F .No12-39/2003-Labour (VI) dated 16th October, 2006, the Lieutenant Governor (Administrator), Andaman and Nicobar Islands, after considering the recommendation of the Advisory Committee appointed under Section 9 of the Minimum Wages Act, 1948 does hereby revise and fix the minimum rates of wages as specified in the Schedule hereto, for Teaching & Non Teaching employed in Educational Institutions/School/Nurseries/Kinder Gardens/Tutorials/Coaching Institutes in Private Sector other than the CBSE affiliated institutions in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands 1st March 2009.



1. The minimum rate of wages are inclusive of the wages for the weekly day of rest and no separate payment would be necessary on this account.
2. The existing mode of remunerating employees on a scale of pay or monthly rates will continue unchanged.
3. The minimum wages rates are applicable to such of the employees are engaged by contractor also.
4. Where prevailing rate of wages of any employees bases on contract or agreement are higher than the rates notified by the Government, the higher wages shall be traded as minimum rates of wages applicable for the purpose of this notification to such employees.
