

PRESS NOTE

The Department of Fisheries, A&N Administration has formulated a scheme under Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana for setting up of new Ice Plant and Cold Storages in the islands. The scheme envisages providing of 25% subsidy on the cost of machinery and equipments subject to a maximum of Rs. 25.00 lakh for setting up of Ice Plant having production capacity of at-least 5 MT per day and 5 MT Cold Storage. The beneficiary should meet 25% of the cost and the remaining 50% shall be Bank finance. The scheme is credit linked with back ended subsidy.

Applications from local interested entrepreneurs / Primary Fisheries Co-op. Societies / Fisheries Co-op. Federation / Self Help Groups are invited for setting up of new Ice Plant and Cold Storage by availing the benefits under the scheme. The applicants are required to submit applications in the prescribed format along with the Detailed Project Report. Format of application and other details of the scheme can be obtained from the Directorate of Fisheries as well from the Fisheries Zonal Offices and Fisheries Sub-Stations. The application can also be downloaded from the A&N Administration website www.and.nic.in. **The last date for submission of duly filled application form along with the enclosures addressed to the Director of Fisheries, A&N Administration, Port Blair is 5th January, 2010.**
