


RASHTRIYA KRISHI VIKAS YOJANA (RKVY)**Guidelines for implementation of the programme**

| 1 | Name of the Programme | Subsidy for Construction of Nursery ponds and breeding materials for freshwater fish seed production |
| 2 | Objective | The programme aims to encourage the local farmers to construct nursery ponds and procure breeding materials to produce fresh water fish seed locally in A&N Islands. |
| 3 | Pattern of Assistance/ Subsidy | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ 50% subsidy subject to a maximum of ₹ 24,000/- for construction of Nursery pond of size 10 x 10 x 1.5 mtr and purchase of one set breeding materials. ▪ The maximum subsidy for construction of nursery pond of size 10 x 10 mtr at surface, 5.5 x 5.5 mtr at bottom and depth of 1.5 mtr with a slope of 1:1.5 would be ₹ 9,000/- whereas a maximum of ₹ 15,000/- will be provided for purchase of one set of breeding materials including 05 Breeding happas, 15 Hatching happas (outer & inner each), 01 Fry collection net, 05 vials (10 ml. each) of inducing agents (Ovaprim/ Ovotide). ▪ Assistance will be available only for new ponds. <p>(The actual amount of subsidy for the construction of Nursery pond and purchase of breeding materials to be decided by a constituted committee).</p> |
| 4 | Eligibility Criteria | <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Farmers/ individuals from A&N Islands. 2) The applicant should be holding a clear title of the land on which the nursery pond is proposed to be constructed (copy of land record alongwith a certificate of ownership from the Revenue Department to be furnished). 3) If the land is on lease, the lease deed shall be for a minimum of 5 years from the date of sanction of subsidy (Copy of lease deed to be furnished). 4) The subsidy assistance would be extended for construction of upto 02 (two) nursery ponds and purchase of upto 02 (two) set of breeding materials. |

| 5 | Procedure for release of subsidy | <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Inviting of applications through local dailies/ AIR/ Fisheries Zonal Offices/ Fisheries Sub Offices/ PRI's/ Municipal Council and Tribal Council. 2) Submission of application by the applicants in the prescribed format. 3) Field verification report and recommendation of the Field Officer and Zonal Fisheries In-charge. 4) Selection of beneficiary through a constituted committee and approval by the competent authority for sanction of admissible subsidy to the selected beneficiary for construction of Nursery ponds and purchase of breeding materials for freshwater fish seed production. 5) Intimation to the selected beneficiaries through the respective Zonal Fisheries In-charges and execution of Agreement bond and Surety Bond by the Asst. Director of Fisheries of the Zonal Office and the beneficiary. 6) Construction of nursery pond and procurement of the asset by the beneficiary. 7) Intimation to the In-charge, Zonal Office / Fisheries Sub Station by the beneficiary. 8) Inspection of the site where nursery pond constructed/ asset procured and verification of the bills by the In-charge, Fisheries Sub Station/ Zonal Office. 9) Forwarding of verified bills, Agreement bond and Surety Bond executed by the beneficiary together with the report of the Zonal In-charge to the Directorate of Fisheries. 10) Release of subsidy to the beneficiary through the bank wherever bank loan is involved, or To the respective agencies that construct the nursery pond and supplies the fish breeding materials where the beneficiary has remitted only the balance cost of the asset excluding the |

Departments/ Autonomous bodies.</p> <p>iv) Any other matter connected with the implementation of the scheme.</p> <p>v) The committee shall meet on as and when required basis.</p> |



AGREEMENT


For grant of 50% subsidy for Construction of Nursery ponds and Breeding materials for freshwater fish seed production

This agreement is made at Port Blair on this day of 20 between Sri/ Smt. s/o/ w/o/ d/o aged about years, residing at in Andaman & Nicobar Islands hereinafter referred to as "**Beneficiary**" (which expression shall unless repugnant to the subject or context or meaning thereof be deemed to include his/ her/ their respective heirs, executors, administrator, legal representatives and assignees) of the FIRST PART, and

The President of India acting through the Assistant Director of Fisheries, Andaman and Nicobar Administration, Port Blair, herein after referred to as the "**Administration**" (Which expression shall unless repugnant to the subject or context or meaning thereof be deemed to include its successors and assignees) of the SECOND PART, and

NOW WHEREAS

1. The Administration has framed a programme called "**Subsidy for Construction of Nursery ponds and breeding materials for freshwater fish seed production**" under the Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana – a plan scheme of the Ministry of Agriculture, Govt. of India (herein after referred to as "**the said programme**") with a view to provide subsidy to the local farmers to construct nursery ponds and procure breeding materials to produce fresh water fish seed in A&N Islands and the said Beneficiary agrees to the terms and conditions laid down under the said programme.
2. Under the said programme, the Beneficiary is eligible for subsidy to the extent of 50% subject to a maximum of ₹ 9,000/- for construction of nursery pond of size 10 x 10 x 1.5 mtr and ₹ 15,000/- for purchase of one set of breeding materials including 05 Breeding happas, 15 Hatching happas (outer/ inner),



01 Fry collection net, 05 vials (10 ml. each) of inducing agents (ovaprim / ovatide).

3. The Beneficiary by his/her application dated the day of 20 has applied to the Administration for grant of subsidy for construction of one/ two nursery ponds of size 10 x 10 x 1.5 mtr at (Village) bearing (Survey No. of the Plot) in (Tehsil) of (Name of the District) in Andaman & Nicobar Islands and purchase of one/ two sets of breeding materials including 05 Breeding happas, 15 Hatching happas (outer/ inner), 01 Fry collection net, 05 vials (10 ml. each) of inducing agents (ovaprim / ovatide).
4. The Administration have agreed to provide ₹ being the 50% cost of construction of one/ two nursery ponds and ₹ being the 50% cost of the item for procurement of one/ two sets of fish breeding materials as subsidy.

NOW THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH and it is hereby agreed by and between the parties here to as under:-

- a) The Beneficiary agrees to construct one/ two nursery ponds of size 10 x 10 x 1.5 mtr at (Village) bearing (Survey No. of the Plot) in (Tehsil) of (Name of the District) in Andaman & Nicobar Islands in accordance with the layout, design cost of the nursery pond as approved and sanctioned by the Administration and procure one/ two sets of fish breeding materials within nine months from the date of sanction of subsidy under the said programme.
- b) The Beneficiary has agreed that no part of the subsidy shall be utilized for purposes other than those for which it is sanctioned.
- c) The Beneficiary agrees that assets created out of the subsidy shall not be disposed off or sold.
- d) The Beneficiary agrees to keep the nursery pond and fish breeding materials in good working condition and carry out repairs when ever necessary at its own expense and to indemnify the Administration against any damage to the nursery pond and loss or damage that may be caused to the fish breeding materials or any part thereof.



- e) The Beneficiary shall permit any officer authorized by the Administration to inspect the condition of the nursery pond and fish breeding materials in such manner as the said officer may deem fit.
- f) If at any time the nursery pond and fish breeding materials are found neglected or in abandoned condition, it shall be lawful for the Administration or any officer authorized by it to order the seizure of fish breeding materials.
- g) If at any time during the period of agreement the Administration notices that the first party misuses or mis-utilises the nursery pond and fish breeding materials for the purpose other than those for which it is sanctioned, the amount subsidized shall be turned into loan and shall be recovered from the Beneficiary in three annual installments with simple interest @ 9% per annum.
- h) This agreement shall remain in force for a period of five years.
- i) In case of the breach of any condition of this agreement by the Beneficiary, the Administration shall have the right to recover the subsidy as arrears of land revenue.
