ADDENDUM

CONTENTS

Under Section 4.3 (b) I to IV the following may be added:

- I. Before granting any new bar license, press release may be made in the matter of granting bar license to the said bar in "The Daily Telegrams", "Dweep Samachar", other private news paper, website etc. for inviting objections, if any, from general public giving 15 days time to file such objections with clear reasoning.
- II. The objections so received may be heard in person to know their genuineness. Only those objections which attract provisions contained in Excise Regulation, Rules Policy and guidelines dated 18.11.2008 & 13.07.2010 may be examined.
- III. Vague representations & those submitted by persons not residing in the area of proposed bar may be summarily rejected.
- IV. Bar licenses may be granted to those applicants in whose case, no representation has been received or to them where representations made have been examined and were not found to make the applicant ineligible for grant of bar license, provided the applicants fulfill all other conditions provided in guidelining order dated 18.11.2008 as amended by order dated 13.07.2010 issued by the Administration.
