Sir,  
As the State Government is aware, India is hosting the Commonwealth Games in Delhi in October, 2010. The President, Indian Olympic Association has brought to the notice of this Department that as a part of Commonwealth Games 2010, the Third Commonwealth Youth Games, 2008 is going to be held at Pune from the 12<sup>th</sup> to 18<sup>th</sup> October, 2008. It is the endeavour of the Indian Olympic Association to coach/select/train those athletes participating/performing in various sport events who are capable of winning medals during the said games, thus improving all the medal tallies for India.

2. In this Department's letter of even No. dated 21<sup>st</sup> January, 2008, the State Government was requested that subject to exigencies of work, the State Government may issue necessary instructions to all State Government Departments/PSUs to permit the employees who are selected for coaching camps/training in India or abroad as athletes, coaches or other attached officials like Doctors, Masseurs, Managers in connection with the 2010 Commonwealth Games and treat their absence as duty for the entire period of stay in the coaching camps and for participating in competitions till 2010 Commonwealth Games.

4. It is requested that State Government may also issue instructions to all the State Government Departments/PSUs to extend similar facility to the employees selected for coaching camps/training in India or abroad as athletes, coaches or other attached officials like Doctors, Masseurs, Managers in connection with the Third Commonwealth Youth Games, 2008, Pune and treat their absence as duty for the entire period of stay in the coaching camps and for participating in competitions till Third Commonwealth Youth Games, 2008 to be held in Pune. However, in accordance with para 3 (iv) of this Department's OM dated 6/1/85-Estt (Pay - I) dated 7.11.1988 the technical officials concerned with the administration of the tournaments will not be treated as part of the teams but would be given the facility of availing 30 days Special Casual Leave in a calendar year.
