Particulars of it's organization, function and duties

A organization chart showing the number of officers and staffs working in the Tribal Welfare Department is given vide Annexure – 1

Function: The Directorate of Tribal Welfare functions under the overall administrative control of Secretary (TW). For day-to-day functioning, the Directorate is headed by a Director (TW) and assisted by Research Officer (TW), Assistant Commissioner (TW) and other supporting staff. Another Administrative unite of the Directorate functions under the Project Officer, ITDP, Car Nicobar to coordinate the implementation of Tribal Sub-Plan. An autonomous body called 'Andaman Adim Janjati Vikas Samithi (AAJVS) which is headed by the Lt. Governor as its Chairman, looks after the welfare of the Primitive Tribes. Grant-in-aid to the AAJVS and Nicobarese Tribal Councils is provided by the Administration from the Union Territory's budget.

Main activities of the Tribal welfare Department include formulation of the Tribal Sub-Plan, Co-ordination with the various departments of the Administration for implementing various schemes and monitoring the progress of implementation of the plan schemes.
