Forest Cover

As per the State of the Forest Report 2011 of the Forest Survey of India about 81.51% of the 8249 sq. km. of geographical area of Andaman & Nicobar Island is under forest cover whose breakup (density-wise) is given in the table below.

Notified Forest

The total notified forest is 7170.69 Sq. Km, which is 86.93% of the total geographical area of the Islands. District wise and category wise details of recorded forest are given in the following table

It may be observed that the notified forest area is 5.42% more than the forest cover of 84.42% of the geographical area of Andaman and Nicobar Islands. This is mainly on account of the fact that notified area also covers grass lands particularly in Nicobar group of islands falling within forest area but not treated as forest cover.
