It is brought to the notice of all concerned that the Ministry of HRD has informed that the issue of allotment of supernumerary seats in various NITs to the States/UTs which do not have NITs will be decided only after the completion of first round of counseling by the Central Counselling Board-2009. However, the Ministry has assured that number of students to be admitted in NITs from the UT of Andaman & Nicobar Islands on the basis of AIEEE-2009 results do not fall below the number of students admitted from the UT in 2007. Further, the counselling of seats will be made on-line off campus and as per contents under Point 13.2 (Page-6) of the Information Bulletin for the AIEEE-2009.
