

**PRESS NOTE**

In continuation of the press note published by the A&N Administration in The Daily Telegrams on 26.05.2010 regarding the procedure for allotment of reserved seats for the students of Andaman and Nicobar Islands in the Professional/Technical/Non-Technical courses at mainland institutions during 2010-11, it is to bring to the notice of general public and all concerned that the condition prescribed at Point No. (xviii) that "The candidates shall be eligible for only one seat, either in NIT or Administration seat, as per eligibility" still holds good. However, since the procedure for allotment of NIT seat has been changed to online off campus counseling and therefore choice filling, admission and allotment has become online, the students are free to accept or reject the online allotment of NIT seat. If any candidate does not accept the allotted NIT seat, the candidate must report this fact to Assistant Secretary (Higher Education), A&N Administration within three days of offer of NIT seat, to be considered for allotment of seat from A&N Administration quota. In that case, the name of such candidates will appear in the merit list published by the Administration for allotment of various Professional/Technical/Non-Technical courses at mainland institutions being allotted by the Administration. If any candidate has reported to any of the NIT Admission Centers and has furnished the required demand draft and other documents accepting the offered NIT seat, his/her name will not be included in the merit list published by the Administration. Once a candidate has accepted an NIT seat and does not report to the respective institution or later cancels his/her allotment for any reasons whatsoever, he/she will not be eligible for any Administration seat under any circumstances.


