The applicant should have passed All India Senior Secondary Certificate Examination or its equivalent examination with English, Physics, Chemistry and Biology securing at least 50% marks (40% of the aggregate marks in the case of candidates belonging to ST or as amended by the Medical Council of India from time to time), subject to the eligibility requirement of the concerned College/University. They should also submit attested copies of Mark Sheet of All India Secondary School Examination (Xth Class) or its equivalent along with copies of other certificates. The merit list will be prepared for the purpose of their selection taking into account the 20% of the total aggregate marks obtained in the AISSE (Class Xth) and 80% of aggregate marks obtained in English, Physics, Chemistry and Biology of the qualifying examination (i.e. XII class) as per the instructions contained in the Govt. of India, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare letter No. U.14014/84/86-ME(UG) dated 09-12-1986.

The candidates, who have passed the B.Sc. or M.Sc. examination can also apply for the allotment of seats. In their cases, 80% weightage will be given to the results of the eligible examination (i.e. XIIth Class), 10% of the result of the Matriculation /SSC examination and 10% of the result of B.Sc. or M.Sc. examination. For a candidate who has passed the qualifying examination in the second attempt, 2% of the marks from the total aggregate shall be deducted in determining his/her merit. Candidates, who have passed the qualifying examination in more than two attempts, will not be considered for Medical courses.

Candidates should have passed All India Senior Secondary Certificate Examination (XIIth Class) with 55% marks in 10+2 (Physics, Chemistry, Biology) (as per Ministry of Health & F.W letter No. R.12013/1/2007-E&C dated 25.04.2007). However, the candidates applying for BHMS seat in NIH Kolkata should obtain at least 50% marks for General Candidates and 45% marks for ST candidates in 10+2 scheme with requisite five subjects which includes English, Physics, Chemistry & Biology from a Statutory Board/Council/University is recognized by the West Bengal University of Health Science and subject to other conditions as per prospectus of NIH, Kolkata.

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Candidates should have appeared AIEEE-2010 for allotment of Degree level engineering courses. The degree level engineering seats will be allotted category-wise based on the state-merit/ranking of the candidates from A&N Islands in AIEEE-2010.

The eligibility requirements of the College/Institution confirmed during last academic year are as under:-

Tamil Nadu

Passed SSCE (XIIth Class) with a minimum of 60% marks in PCM in aggregate and for ST students mere pass.

Kerala

Candidates must have 50% marks in Mathematics separately, and 50% marks in Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry put together. For ST students pass in the qualifying examination. Candidates should have completed 17 years of age as on 31st Dec, 2009.

Maharashtra

Passed SSCE with 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry & Maths taken together.
(ST need 40% marks in PCM).

For Architecture Degree Course :- The candidates nominated by the concerned States shall be admitted in Govt./Govt. Aided or Private Institutes only and only if they fulfill the eligibility criteria of DTE, Maharashtra. For admission in Govt./ Govt. Aided institutes the candidates must have been appeared for the Aptitude Test either conducted by the respective state or conducted by competent authority of Maharashtra State and regarding admission in Private Institutes it is mandatory to qualify the National Aptitude Test in Architecture (NATA) as per notification of Council of Architecture, New Delhi.

Karnataka and Orissa

Passed SSCE with 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry & Maths taken together.
(ST need 40% marks in PCM).

(d) B. (Pharmacy) Code 15 5 seats

AISSE with minimum 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics and Biology.

Goa

The applicant should have passed the Higher Secondary School Certificate (Std. XIIth) examination of the Goa Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent examination with English, Physics and Chemistry as compulsory subjects with one of the following subjects Maths/Bio-Technology/ Computer Science/Biology and secured not less than 50% marks in the aggregate of subjects of Physics & Chemistry with one of the following subjects Maths/Bio-Technology/ Computer Science/Biology, obtained in one and the same sitting. (40% for the applicants belonging to ST only).

(e) Hotel Management Code 16 10seats

Candidates should have passed +2 examination of 10+2 system or equivalent examination in any stream with English as a compulsory subject with at least 50% marks in aggregate, relaxable by 5% in the case of ST candidates. Candidate should not be more than 22 years of age as on 01/07/2010, relaxable upto 25 years for ST candidates.

(f) One Year Craft Course Code 18 10 seats

Candidates should have passed plus 2 examination of 10+2 system or equivalent examination in any stream with English as compulsory subject with at-least 50% marks in aggregate, relaxable by 5% in the case of ST candidates. Candidate should not be more than 22 years of age as on 01/06/2010, relaxable upto 25 years for ST candidates.

**(g) Printing Technology/
Photography Code 23 2 seats
(One seat each)**

Candidates must have passed the Madhyamic or equivalent exam with Maths and Physical Science from a recognized Board of Secondary Education with 60% marks on Maths and Physical Science taken together. They should also able to communicate/write in English properly. The maximum age should be 21 years as on 1st Jan, 2010 with 3 years relaxation for ST candidates.

**(ii) Diploma - 2 Code 30 8 seats
(Diploma Pharmacy)**

As per Govt. of India's letter dated 27-01-1995, an aggregate of 60% marks in PCM in single sitting is required for Diploma programme in Engineering. However the following marks obtained by the candidates in the above disciplines will also be considered, subject to any change in eligibility criteria fixed by the host Institutions.

- (i) Diploma-1 - XIIth pass with 50% marks in Maths separately and 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Maths put together.
- (ii) Diploma-2 - Passed Senior secondary certificate examination (XIIth class) with 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Biology(aggregate).
- (iii) Diploma-3 - Xth pass with 50% marks in Maths and 50% marks in General Science and Maths put together.

(i) B.Sc. B.Ed. Code 56 3 seats

Candidates should have passed in +2 Science with minimum 50% marks in aggregate. The candidates should have either the subject combination of (a) Maths, Physics and Chemistry or (b) Biology, Physics and Chemistry at +2 level. The candidates who have passed +2 Science Examination before 2009 will not be considered for admission.

(j) BL Integrated Course Code 62 2 seats

Candidates should have obtained a minimum of 45% marks in the aggregate in the qualifying examination 10+2/AISSCE/12th Class. Marks obtained in English should not be less than 50% (A mere pass is enough in the case of ST candidates).

(k) General Nursing Code 63 12 seats

(i) Kerala – 2 (ii) Bangalore – 5 (Female unmarried) (iii) Kolkata – 5

(i) The eligibility requirement in Kerala, the candidate should pass in All India Senior School Certificate Examination (XIIth Class) with Physics, Chemistry and Biology with 50% marks in Biology separately and 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Biology put together.

(ii) The eligibility requirement in Bangalore, the candidate should pass in Higher Secondary Exam (XII class) or equivalent. Candidates must be completed 17 years of age as on 01.09.2010.

(iii) The eligibility requirement in Kolkata, the candidate should pass in Higher Secondary Exam (XII class) or equivalent. Candidates must be completed 18 years of age as on 01.01.2010.

**(l) B.Sc. (Nursing) Code 64 02 Seats
Female (unmarried)**

Candidates should have passed All India Senior Certificate Examination or its equivalent with English, Physics, Chemistry and Biology securing at least 50% marks in aggregate subject to variation as per the requirements of the concerned University/ Institution. Relaxation of 5% for ST candidates. Candidate should have completed 17 years of age on or before 31/12/2010.

(m) Para Medical Courses Code 65 05 Seats

Eligibility requirements for Para Medical Courses (i-iv)

Candidates should have passed the +2/Higher Secondary/Pre-degree or equivalent examination with Physics, Chemistry and Biology as optional subjects for admission provided that they have secured an aggregate of 50% marks in optional subjects. Relaxation of 10% marks will be allowed to candidate of ST. Applicant should have completed 17 years of age as on 30.07.2010 and upper age limit is 30 as on 30.09.2010.

(n) B.Sc (Agriculture) - Code 81 08 Seats

Candidates should have passed in the HSC (10+2) with 55% aggregate in any of the combination of four subjects :

- (i) Maths, Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Computer Science/Statistics.
- (ii) Botany, Physics, Chemistry, Zoology
- (iii) Biology, Physics, Chemistry, Computer Science

For ST candidates, a pass in qualifying examination with qualifying subjects.

Candidate should not have completed the age of 21 years as on 31.07.2010. For ST candidates, there is no age limit.

(o) B.Sc (Horticulture) - Code 82 05 Seats

Candidates should have passed in the HSC (10+2) with 55% aggregate in any of the combination of four subjects :


- (i) Maths, Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Computer Science/Statistics.
- (ii) Botany, Physics, Chemistry, Zoology
- (iii) Biology, Physics, Chemistry, Computer Science

For ST candidates, a pass in qualifying examination with qualifying subjects.

Candidate should not have completed the age of 21 years as on 31.07.2010. For ST candidates, there is no age limit.

General Conditions:

- (i) For determining merits of MBBS, BDS, BAMS, BHMS, Hotel Management, B.Sc. B.Ed, Nursing courses etc except Degree/Diploma level Engineering/ B.Pharmacy seats, +2 qualifying exam marks will be taken and marks obtained in practical will not be taken into account.
- (ii) Candidates shall indicate the area code for which they would like to be considered as per Annexure 'A' of the application format.
- (iii) Local Certificate and other Certificates as stated in the Application Form should be attached with the application.
- (iv) Eligibility criteria is subject to change as per revised criteria of the Institutions/ College, if any.
- (v) The Application Form contains all the required information such as name of courses, area code, and name of the mainland Institutions/Colleges etc. Candidates shall have to indicate the code number of areas in boxes provided for the purpose.
- (vi) Application in the prescribed form dully filled in shall be submitted to the Education Section of the Secretariat (Dev.IV), A & N Administration, Port Blair in person on or before 3.00 p.m. on 21/06/2010. No applications will be accepted after 3.00 p.m. on 21.06.2010 under any circumstances. The candidates shall be eligible for only one seat, either NIT or Administration seat.
- (vii) Nomination once accepted will be treated as final. Similarly no request will be entertained for change of seat/institutions/colleges. The institutions once selected at the time of counseling will be final.
- (viii) Once a seat is allotted she/he is not eligible for any other seat or to change his/her preference.
- (ix) In the event of any information being found false or ineligibility detected before or after the admission, his/her nomination will be cancelled and appropriate action as deemed fit will be taken against the nominee.
