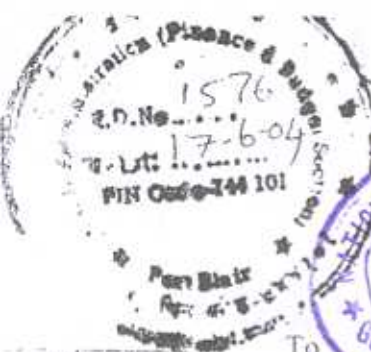


Sub: Delegation of power to the Lt. Governor, A&N Islands to sanction air travel in connection with medical treatment - Regarding.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the A&N Administration's letter No.3-5(DFP)/93-Fin dated the 21st April, 2004 on the above cited subject and to convey the sanction of the President to delegate the powers to the Lt. Governor, A&N Islands to allow air travel to sick Government employees of the UT Administration or members of their family by a civil aircraft from any part of the A&N Islands to the nearest hospital on the mainland which may be on the route of the aircraft, provided the Chief Medical Officer in the Islands certifies that air lift is necessary and urgent for medical treatment of the patient and that travel by any other mode would definitely endanger the life of the patient or involve serious aggravation of his/her condition. Sanction of air travel for an attendant or escort along with employee or a member of his/her family may also be accorded if it is certified by the Chief Medical Officer that it is absolutely necessary for escort/attendant to travel with the patient being air-lifted for urgent medical treatment.

2. The delegation of power will be valid from 1st April, 2004 to 31st March, 2007 on the existing terms and conditions.
3. The exercise of these powers is subject to general or special orders issued by the President from time to time.
4. This issues with the concurrence of the Ministry of Finance (Department of Expenditure) vide their U.O. No.378/EV/2004 dated 31st May, 2004 and Integrated Finance Division of Ministry of Home Affairs vide their Dy. No.810/AFA(P)/04 dated 8th June, 2004.
