CIRCULAR

The Ministry of Home Affairs vide their letter No.15039/4/2003-Plg.Cell (Part) dated 11th May, 2005 has conveyed the sanction of the Government of India for enhanced delegation of powers to the Lt. Governor, Andaman and Nicobar Islands under Rules 18 and 21 of Delegation of Financial Powers Rules, 1978 for sanction of works, Indent, Contract, Purchases etc. as under:

| 1. Sanction of works | From Rs.5 cr. to Rs.10 cr. |
| 2. Normal contract/purchase | From Rs.2 cr. to Rs.5 cr. |
| 3. Negotiated/single tender contract | From Rs.0.80 cr. to Rs.1 cr. |
| 4. Indent for stores of proprietary nature | From Rs.0.40 cr. to Rs.1 cr. |
| 5. Indent for stores of proprietary nature
(for power sector only) | From Rs.2 cr. to Rs.3 cr. |
| 6. Direct purchase on grounds of
emergency | From Rs.0.20 cr. to Rs.0.30 cr. |

The above enhanced delegation has been approved subject to (i) the prescribed procedure for entering into contract and making purchases being followed: and (ii) the power being exercised in consultation with the Finance Secretary of U.T. Administration.
