
Sub: Recommendation for Padma Awards-reg.

I am directed to enclose herewith a copy of proforma received from the Ministry of Home Affairs regarding awarding of **Padma Awards** namely, **Padma Vibhusan, Padma Bhusan and Padma Sri**, to the deserving persons, which are to be announced on the eve of Republic Day, 2006

The following guidelines are to be borne in mind while recommending the awards to the person of respective departments and the proforma duly filled in all respect should reach this Administration by 15th September for onward submission to the Ministry.

- a) It may be ensured that the person recommended for the award is preeminently worthy of the award. We should, infact, look for life time achievement. The criteria for selection has to be 'excellence plus'. It is necessary that highest standards are applied while recommending persons for these awards. It may also be kept in view that there is an element of public service in the achievement of the person recommended for the award.
- b) Efforsts may be made to identify talented persons from amongst the weaker sections of the society like SCs & STs handicapped persons, women, etc., who deserve to be decorated with the award.
- c) State/UT Governments are not expected to recommend officials of the Central Government (posted in States) for these awards. However, if they wish to recommend the name of a Central Government official, they may bring his/her name to the notice of the concerned Ministry/Department of the Central Government.



- d) Where a person employed under any autonomous organization or public sector undertaking of the Government is recommended for any of these awards, it may be ensured that his/her employer is invariably consulted.
- e) The decoration is normally not conferred posthumously. However, in highly deserving cases, Government could consider giving an award posthumously if the person proposed to be honoured has died recently, say within a period of one year preceding the Republic Day on which it is proposed to announce the award.
