Sub:- Grant of Honorarium to Govt. servant deployed for Relief & Rehabilitation work – regarding.

I am directed to say that the matter regarding payment of Honorarium to the Govt. servant performed duty in connection with Relief & Rehabilitation work in the aftermath of tsunami was under the consideration of this Administration for past some time on the basis of proposal received from various HODs from time to time. The matter has been examined in consultation with the Finance Department.

It has now been decided to make payment of Honorarium at a uniform rate of Rs.2500/- in deserving cases to such employees those who have not been paid honorarium for this specific work so far, subject to fulfillment of terms and conditions and availability of funds for the purpose.

Heads of Deptts. who is competent to grant Honorarium as per Rule may therefore, consider the cases of employees working in the respective Deptt. who have performed duty in connection with Relief & Rehabilitation work and not been paid honorarium or any other remuneration so far, subject to the availability of fund within the budget grant. However, it may please be noted that it may not be possible to provide additional fund for the purpose over and above the sanctioned budget of the respective Department. This may be met out of normal savings under concerned Head of accounts.
