**RESTRICTION ON NUMBER OF VEHICLES AND PEOPLE AT
THE TIME OF NOMINATIONS**


A large number of vehicles and people accompanying some of the candidates at the time of filing nominations was causing serious concern about general order in the offices of Returning Officers. Keeping this in view, the Election Commission of India has issued instructions that the maximum number of vehicles to be allowed to come within a periphery of 100 Mtrs. of the Returning Officer's office has been restricted to 3 (three) and the maximum number of persons that can be allowed to enter the office of the Returning Officer at the time of filing nominations has been limited to 5 (Five) (including the candidate). Any violation to this instruction at the time of filing nomination papers will be seriously viewed and action will be taken against the candidate or his party responsible for violation.
