PRESS NOTE

Inviting of applications against the allocation of MBBS seats from Central Pool for spouse and children of terrorist victims for the academic year 2017-18

It is brought to the notice of all concerned that as per the communication received from the Under Secretary to the Govt. of India, Ministry of Home Affairs, Internal Security Division, New Delhi, 4 (four) seats in MBBS course in the following institutes have been allocated from the Central Pool for nomination of candidates from the category of Civilian Terrorist Victims:-

The Ministry has further informed that the following order of priority has been prescribed for allocation of MBBS/BDS seat to the wards of civilian victims of terrorism:-


- Priority I : Children whose both parents have been killed by terrorists.
- Priority II : Children of families whose sole bread earners have been killed by terrorists.
- Priority III : Wards of victims with permanent disability and serious injury caused by terrorist operations.

The Under Secretary, Ministry of Home Affairs has further informed that the selection of candidates will be made on the basis of rank obtained in the National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test (NEET)-2017 being conducted by CBSE, New Delhi. It shall be necessary for the candidates to obtain minimum marks at 50th percentile at NEET 2017. However, in respect of candidates belonging to SC, ST, the minimum marks shall be at 40th percentile. In respect of candidates with locomotory disability of lower limbs, the minimum marks shall be at 45th percentile.

The application form can be obtained from the Development Section-IV, Secretariat, Port Blair from 26.08.2017 to 28.08.2017 or download from the websites www.and.nic.in and www.andaman.gov.in. The filled application form alongwith attested copies of necessary certificates/testimonial and other documentary evidence of Terrorist Victim may be submitted in person **to the Development-IV Section of the Secretariat, Port Blair on or before 28th August, 2017 upto 3.00 pm positively**. Incomplete applications will summarily be rejected.

No application will be entertained or accepted after the expiry of the stipulated date and time as specified above.
